About the Virtues to Live by logo

The logo is in the shape of a tree. This symbolises the importance of our growth in the virtues.

The trunk of the tree is Jesus and the leaves symbolise each one of us, and the eight chosen virtues:

- Faith = golden yellow
- Hope = **green** •
- Love = red
- Justice = **blue**
- Solidarity = purple
- Temperance = yellow
- Courage = orange
- Practical wisdom = silver



The image echoes John's Gospel 15:15 "Those who remain in me, and I in them, will bear much fruit; for you can do nothing without me." Our closeness to Jesus gives us the grace to flourish – "live life to the full" (John 10:10)

The yellow inside the circle represents heaven.

The figure of Jesus is both in heaven and on earth. Jesus, God's Son, was born, lived and died on earth so he is someone we can trust to guide us in the right path. As each of us fixes our eyes on Jesus (Hebrews 12:2), just as the leaves appear to be fixed on him, he will quide us to our heavenly home.
